**PROCESS:** The Student fills out this form at the start of the term in which the course is being taught and gets the instructor's prior approval. For the grade-based credit (Option A), the student turns the form in to the CS Department Graduate Secretary. For conditions-based credit (Option B), at the end of the class the student gives the form back to the faculty member, who signs the form indicating the conditions have been met. The student turns the form in to the CS Department Graduate Secretary, who will inform the Registrar's office of the outcome. For option B, the verification signature must be received and turned in by the end of the term following the completion of the course.
